HWY. 183 MUNICIPAL BURIAL PARK  
RULES AND REGULATIONS  
Per City Code**

**Sec. 14-32 Special Restrictions for Northeast Section, Blocks IV, V, and VI**

- (1) Raised headstones and/or markers above existing natural ground surfaces shall not be allowed.
- (2) The planting of trees, shrubs, bushes, flowers or any other type of plant or grass shall not be allowed.
- (3) No curbing or enclosure of any type shall be allowed around burial spaces or lots
- (4) Vases for flowers shall only be the inverted type that can be buried when not in use and during mowing activities, except as provided in subsection (5) below. In no case shall any vase be taller than 15" above natural ground and any wider than 4" in diameter at the top. Only one vase shall be allowed for each burial space. All non-conforming vases will not be allowed and shall be removed and disposed of by cemetery maintenance personnel at no liability to the City of Lockhart.
- (5) Flowers, both artificial and natural, with vases or other containers, will be allowed for up to five (5) days after interment. Those remaining after the five (5) days will then be removed and disposed of by cemetery maintenance personnel at no liability to the City of Lockhart.
- (6) Flags for veterans of war shall be allowed as long as they are contained within the allowable flower vase. Cemetery maintenance personnel at no liability to the City of Lockhart shall remove and dispose of flags that are damaged and/or faded.
- (7) Benches and all other appurtenances shall not be allowed under any circumstance.
- (8) A concrete liner or other approved non-deteriorating liner shall be required for each grave space prior to interment, with the exception being the placement of approved burial cremation urns.
- (9) Cemetery maintenance personnel shall perform all watering activities.
- (10) Special surface coverings of grave spaces, such as but not limited to gravel, concrete, artificial grass, shall not be allowed. All surface areas shall be natural grass.
- (11) The order in which "lots" are to be sold shall be as determined by the Public Works Director or designee. When 90% of the spaces within a particular lot are sold, the spaces in the next designated lot as determined by the Public Works Director or designee may be sold.
- (12) All other provisions and requirements of other sections in Chapter 14, Cemeteries, of the Code of Ordinances, shall apply except for those in direct conflict with the provisions of this section, Section 14-32.
