<u>Section 551.076</u>. To deliberate the deployment, or specific occasions for implementation, of security personnel or devices. <u>Section 551.086</u>. To deliberate vote or take final action on any competitive matters relating to public power utilities.

Section 551.087. To deliberate or discuss regarding commercial or financial information that the governmental body has received from a business prospect that the governmental body seeks to have locate, stay, or expand in or near the territory of the governmental body and with which the governmental body is conducting economic development negotiations; or to deliberate the offer of a financial or other incentive to a business prospect.

Section 551.088. To deliberate a test item or information related to a test item if the governmental body believes that the test item may be included in a test the governmental body administers to individuals who seek to obtain or renew a license or certificate that is necessary to engage in an activity.

After discussion of any matters in executive session, any final action or vote taken will be in public by the City Council.

ORDINANCE NO. 2017-35

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOCKHART, TEXAS RATIFYING A PROPERTY TAX INCREASE OF 6.062820 PERCENT FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2017-2018 FOR THE USE AND SUPPORT OF THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT FOR THE CITY OF LOCKHART; AND PROVIDING FOR A PUBLICATION CLAUSE, SEVERABILITY CLAUSE, AND REPEALING CLAUSE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOCKHART, TEXAS:

SECTION I.

That this budget will raise more total property taxes than last year's budget by \$374,686 or 11.226207%, and of that amount \$132,596 is tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax -roll this year based on an ad valorem rate of 72.60 cents per each 100 dollars property valuation.

SECTION II.

That the 2017 taxable value on the 2017 certified appraisal roll totals \$569,798,786 compared to \$545,217,170 in 2016. An additional \$41,520,297 of taxable value is still under protest.

SECTION III.

That the proposed Fiscal Year 2018 Budget and Tax Levy shall be adopted in separate ordinances and will become effective October 1, 2017, and end September 30, 2018.

SECTION IV. Publication Clause

The City Secretary of the City of Lockhart is hereby authorized and directed to publish the caption of this ordinance in the manner and for the length of time prescribed by law.

SECTION V. Severability Clause

The provisions of this ordinance are severable, and if any sentence, section, or other parts of this ordinance should be found to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the remaining provisions, and the remaining provisions shall continue in full force and effect.

SECTION VI. Repealing Clause

All ordinances and resolutions and parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby expressly repealed insofar as they conflict.

SECTION VII.

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

ORDINANCE 2017-37

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOCKHART, TEXAS LEVYING MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS PROPERTY TAXES FOR THE USE AND SUPPORT OF THE CITY OF LOCKHART, TEXAS AND INTEREST AND SINKING PROPERTY TAXES FOR THE DEBT SERVICE OBLIGATIONS OF THE CITY OF LOCKHART RESULTING IN A TAX INCREASE OF 6.062820 PERCENT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2018, BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2017 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2018, AND APPROPRIATING EACH PART THEREOF FOR THE SPECIFIC PURPOSES, PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR REPEALER; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the State Legislature enacted Senate Bill 18, which mandated that municipal ordinances establishing annual tax rates must describe an increase in total maintenance and operations taxes compared to the previous year, and the rise of such taxes on a \$100,000 home compared to the previous year.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOCKHART, TEXAS, THAT:

- 1. There is hereby levied and shall be collected a maintenance and operations (M&O) property tax for the use and support of the municipal government of the City of Lockhart, Texas and there is hereby levied and shall be collected an interest and sinking (I&S) property tax to provide for the debt service obligations of the City of Lockhart for Fiscal Year 2018, beginning October 1, 2017, upon all taxable property, within the corporate limits of the City of Lockhart, Texas, as follows:
 - a. For the maintenance and operations needs of the City of Lockhart the maintenance and operations (M&O) property tax is hereby adopted as 60.77 cents per each 100 dollars of property valuation. The tax rate will raise more taxes for maintenance and operations than last year's tax rate. The tax rate will effectively be raised by 7.9204 percent and will raise taxes for maintenance and operations on a \$100,000 home by approximately \$44.60; and.
 - b. For the debt service obligations of the City of Lockhart interest and sinking (I&S) property tax is hereby adopted as 11.83 cents per each 100 dollars of property valuation.
- All taxes levied under the Ordinance for the specific purposes named herein shall be and is hereby
 approved to be collected and appropriated to the account(s) of the City of Lockhart for the specific
 purpose indicated in each items a and b above, by the Property Tax Assessor/Collector of the City of
 Lockhart.
- 3. Severability: if any provision, section, clause, sentence or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional, void, invalid, or unenforceable, the validity of the remainder of this ordinance or its application shall not be affected, it being the intent of the City Council in adopting and approving this ordinance that no portion, provision, or regulation contained herein shall be inoperative or fail by any reasons of any unconstitutionality or invalidity of any other portion, provision or regulation.
- 4. Repeal: That all other ordinances, sections, or parts of ordinances heretofore adopted by the City of Lockhart in conflict with provisions set out above in this ordinance are hereby repealed or amended as indicated.
- 5. Effective date: This ordinance shall become effective and be in full force immediately upon its passage.

Texas Local Government Code Chapter 143 - Civil Service

Sec. 143.021. CLASSIFICATION; EXAMINATION REQUIREMENT.

(a) The commission shall provide for the classification of all fire fighters and police officers. The municipality's governing body shall establish the classifications by ordinance. The governing body by ordinance shall prescribe the number of positions in each classification.



- (b) Except for the department head and a person the department head appoints in accordance with Section 143.014 or 143.102, each fire fighter and police officer is classified as prescribed by this subchapter and has civil service protection. The failure of the governing body to establish a position by ordinance does not result in the loss of civil service benefits by a person entitled to civil service protection or appointed to the position in substantial compliance with this chapter.
- (c) Except as provided by Sections $\underline{143.013}$, $\underline{143.014}$, $\underline{143.0251}$, $\underline{143.102}$, and $\underline{143.1251}$, an existing position or classification or a position or classification created in the future either by name or by increase in salary may be filled only from an eligibility list that results from an examination held in accordance with this chapter.

ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOCKHART, TEXAS ESTABLISHING THE CLASSIFICATIONS WITHIN THE POLICE DEPARTMENT AND AUTHORIZING THE NUMBER OF EMPLOYEES IN EACH-CLASSIFICATION; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING A REPEALER; PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Lockhart has adopted Civil Service, Chapter 143 of the Texas Local Government Code for its Fire and Police Department employees; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 143, the City Council shall establish the classifications of employees and prescribe the number of positions in each classification pursuant to Chapter 143.021(a) of the Texas Local Government Code; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOCKHART, TEXAS, THAT

I. The classifications and number of positions in each classification in the Police Department shall now be as follows:

Effective October 1, 2010 (per Ordinance 2010-32)

- 1. Police Chief 1
- 2. Captain -1
- 3. Lieutenant 2
- 4. Sergeant 4
- 5. Police Officer 16

Effective January 1, 2011 (per Ordinance 2010-32)

- 1. Police Chief 1
- 2. Captain -1
- 3. Lieutenant 2
- 4. Sergeant 4
- 5. Police Officer 17

Effective October 1, 2015

- 1. Police Chief 1
- 2. Captain -1
- 3. Lieutenant 2
- 4. Sergeant 4
- 5. Police Officer 19

- III. Severability: If any provision, section, clause, sentence, or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional, void, invalid, or un-enforced, the validity of the remainder of this ordinance or its application shall not be affected, it being the intent of the City Council in adopting and of the Mayor in approving this ordinance that no portion, provision, or regulation contained herein shall become inoperative or fail by way of reasons of any unconstitutionality or invalidity of any other portion, provision, or regulation.
- IV. Repealer: That all other ordinances, section, or parts of ordinances heretofore adopted by the City of Lockhart in conflict with the provisions set out above in this ordinance are hereby repealed or amended as indicated.

Sec. 143.021. CLASSIFICATION; EXAMINATION REQUIREMENT.

(a) The commission shall provide for the classification of all fire fighters and police officers. The municipality's governing body shall establish the classifications by ordinance. The governing body by ordinance shall prescribe the number of positions in each classification.

- (b) Except for the department head and a person the department head appoints in accordance with Section 143.014 or 143.102, each fire fighter and police officer is classified as prescribed by this subchapter and has civil service protection. The failure of the governing body to establish a position by ordinance does not result in the loss of civil service benefits by a person entitled to civil service protection or appointed to the position in substantial compliance with this chapter.
- (c) Except as provided by Sections 143.013, 143.014, 143.0251, 143.102, and 143.1251, an existing position or classification or a position or classification created in the future either by name or by increase in salary may be filled only from an eligibility list that results from an examination held in accordance with this chapter.
