Physical Demand	Description
Standing/Walking:	For most job tasks. On asphalt, gravel, grass, dirt and mud.
Handling:	To operate the majority of landscape tools and equipment which include shovels, rakes, motorized equipment and in use of basic handtools.
Lifting/Carrying:	Various types of landscape equipment: Chainsaws (10-18 lbs.), weed eaters (14 lbs.) edger (63 lbs.), push mower (63 lbs.), into and out of the bed of a pickup truck (approximate bed height - 40 inches); to pick up tree limbs, trash, land scape tools (shovels, rakes and posthole diggers), hoses and other park maintenance tools and equipment (up to 50 lbs.); to prune trees and remove limbs and logs (from 3lbs to 65 lbs.), from pruning area to trailer; to carry various other objects throughout the work day.
Pushing/Pulling:	To start various landscape equipment: chainsaw (pull strength 8 lbs.); lawnmower and edger (pull strength 24 lbs.); to operate lawnmowers and edgers; to saw tree limbs with polesaw or pruning saw.
Reaching:	Overhead reach to prune trees; operate polesaw.
Bending:	To pick up trash and other items in areas; to remove items from pickup truck bed; to perform basic preventive maintenance on pickup trucks and other landscape equipment.
Vision:	To operate motor vehicle and all other equipment; perform repair & maintenance tasks.
Sitting:	To drive to worksite locations.
Kneeling:	To edge and clean flower beds.
Crouching:	To trim bushes and flower beds; to maintain water systems and fences.
Twisting:	To prune trees; rake; perform other landscaping activities.
Climbing/Balancing:	To use ladders to prune trees and perform basic park maintenance.
Foot Controls:	To operate pickup trucks & lawn mowers.

MACHINES, TOOLS, EQUIPMENT AND WORK AIDES

Lawn mower, edger, trimmer, chainsaw, pruning tools, wheelbarrow, blower, hoses, rake, shovel, posthole digger, pruning shears, basic handtools.

ENVIRONMENTAL FACTORS

Work in various weather conditions, including hot and humid situations; occasional chlorine contact when performing maintenance of City Pools; work in or near road traffic and heights; work with power equipment, mowers and chainsaws.

PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT

Hard hat, safety glasses, gloves, boots, protective outer wear, orange vests and safety cones.
